1. Project 0045-0089, Route 59 Shared Use Path, Easton: This project will design and construction approximately 2,800 linear feet of a shared use path for bike/ped use on the east side of CT Route 59 (Sport Hill Rd) between No. 360 (Hellen Keller Middle School) and No. 451 (Silverman Farm) in the Village Center. In 2019, the GBVMPO ranked this project as the first priority for Transportation Alternatives funding.
