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RESOLUTION 2020-04 AMENDMENT FFY 2018-2021 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FTA PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Greater Bridgeport and Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is authorized by the *Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act)* and related US Department of Transportation regulations to prepare, endorse; and periodically amend a short range Transportation Improvement Program for the 10-town MPO area within the Bridgeport-Stamford Urbanized Area;

WHEREAS, the MPO endorsed the *FFY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for* the Greater Bridgeport and Valley Planning Regions (TIP) at its June 15th, 2017 meeting; and the US Department of Transportation (Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration) have approved the State FFY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (STIP);

WHEREAS, the *FAST Act* allocates funds to the State of Connecticut under various federal transportation assistance programs administered by the Federal Highway Administration;

WHEREAS, the *FAST Act* planning guidelines require the *TIP/STIP* to be fiscally constrained to available program funds;

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Department of Transportation is requesting amendments to the *TIP/STIP* to add program funding to continue on-going projects listed in the current *TIP/STIP*;

WHEREAS, these amendments represent minor modifications of the *TIP/STIP* and involve projects that are exempt from the regional emissions analyses and do not necessitate a new air quality analysis;

WHEREAS, the public notification and review of these proposed amendments was consistent with and followed the procedures set forth in the MPO's *Public Participation Plan*, as amended, and the proposed amendments are consistent with the goals and objectives of the Metropolitan Transportation Plans of the Greater Bridgeport and Valley Planning Region.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Greater Bridgeport and Valley MPO endorses the amendment of the *FFY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program* to include the projects as described and listed in the attachment to this resolution.

This resolution shall become effective as of July 30, 2020.

AMENDMENT FFY 2018-2021 STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP/STIP): FTA PROGRAMS

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is requesting the following amendments to the FFY 2018-2021 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP/TIP).

1. <u>Project 0410-xxxx, GBT Fareboxes:</u> This project includes the replacement of GBT's fare collection system including fare boxes (60), ancillary equipment (portable vaults), probing equipment, hardware and software, mobile fare collection equipment and the associated software and hardware. GBT's current farebox system is approaching thirteen years in service and is at the end of its useful life.

2. Project 0410-xxxx, GBT Cross Street Facility Rehab: This project includes the renovation of several areas at GBT's Cross Street Administrative and Maintenance Facility including the Parts Room/Shipping and Receiving, The Foreman's Offices and Clean Room, the Fixed Route/Demand Response Dispatch Center, the Administrative Break Room and the Bus Probing/Currency Room. The project also includes painting of select locations in GBT maintenance facility. This is a follow-on to a \$250,000 request in a previous grant and the supplemental funding request is based on GBT's design team's current opinion of probable cost for the project.

During the past several years, GBT has completed a series of state of good repair projects at Cross Street including, the maintenance roof replacement, UST (fuel) replacement, bus lift replacement, steam bay rehabilitation, perimeter fencing, bus wash rehabilitation and replacement, electrical switchgear replacement and select painting in these areas as projects complete. This project is a continuation of that work and addresses improvements in areas which have had no such improvements since 1987.

3. Project 0036-xxxx, NVCOG/VTD-Admin Capital/Support Equip/Scv: This amendment will increase Administrative/Support Equipment project funding by \$500,000 total (from \$120,000 federal). Additional funding is necessary for VTD to purchase replace/upgrade computer hardware and software, replace office furniture and equipment, replace/upgrade maintenance and purchase and install bus shelters.
