Fairfield:

- Brookside Drive bridge (03697) replacement
- King's Highway: bicycle & pedestrian improvements, Phase 3
- Black Rock Turnpike safety improvements
- Southport Post Road/Route 1 neighborhood improvements

Monroe:

- Judd Road bridge (04929) over Mill River, borders with Easton
- Wheelers/Route 110 intersection improvements (safety)

Stratford: Broad Street and Ferry Blvd elevation; replace bridge over Ferry Creek (06133)

Trumbull: Spring Hill Road lane (transfer station for Easton & Monroe) & PRT head

Regional: Placeholders for 2 planning studies (out years)
