- 1. Amendment FFY 2018-2021 TIP/STIP, FHWA Projects, Resolution 2021-03
 - Project 0173-0504, Replace Highway Illumination System: I-91 in New Haven, North Haven and Wallingford; Route 40 in North Haven and Hamden; Routes 22 and 5 in North Haven; SR 702 in Wallingford; Routes 25 and 111 in Trumbull and I-95 in Bridgeport.
 - ii. Project 0174-0442, Replace Traffic Control Signals at Various Locations: District 4.
