EPA Climate Pollution Reduction Grants (CPRG) - <https://www.epa.gov/inflation-reduction-act/climate-pollution-reduction-grants>; \$1 million in formula funds are provided to 67 most populous MSAs. MetroCOG is acting as the lead agency for the Bridgeport-Stamford MSA. The TTAC will be asked for feedback and provided with updates. An application is in development. Due May 31st.
 - c. Promoting Resilient Operations for Transformative, Efficient, and Cost-saving Transportation Program (PROTECT). Planning and Implementation grants available.
