RESOLUTION OF THE CONNECTICUT METROPOLITAN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AERIAL PICTOMETRY UPGRADE

I certify that the following is a true copy of the vote of the Connecticut Metropolitan Council of Governments on November 21st, 2019, Bridgeport, Connecticut, a quorum being present: **WHEREAS**, the Connecticut Metropolitan Council of Governments has been awarded grant funds under the *Regional Services Grant (RSG)* to provide services to support regional and municipal programs, included but not limited to regional GIS and digital mapping services;

WHEREAS, MetroCOG continues to maintain the regional GIS, including periodic collection of aerial photography;

WHEREAS, maintenance of the GIS is funded through RSG and local dues;

WHEREAS, member municipalities have requested an update of the regional Pictometry (oblique) aerial imagery in the system; and

WHEREAS, the project will be funded by a combination of RSG and local funds totaling \$90,634.50 with MetroCOG contributing \$20,000 and the remainder divided among municipalities utilizing the current MetroCOG dues calculation formula.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the MetroCOG hereby authorizes the Council's Executive Director, Matthew Fulda, to act on behalf of the Connecticut Metropolitan Council of Governments to enter into an agreement with Pictometry International Corporation, to conduct a regional photography flight for the continued updating and support of the Regional GIS system.
