Mr. Nielsen explained that the amendment was a request for additional funding to purchase VTD vehicles, which had increased in price.

ii. <u>0410-xxxx</u>: Greater Bridgeport Transit; administration, capital and miscellaneous support, Cross Street facility improvements, Water Street Intermodal Center, battery replacement for buses and repower buses.

Mr. Carleton explained that the funding was to support capital improvements and noted updates and upgrades.

Mr. Holcomb added that the project would keep the GBT fleet going.

The motion carried unanimously.
