Minutes

I. CALL TO ORDER MPO Chairman

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. September 28, 2023

Amendment FFY 2021-2024 TIP/STIP, FHWA Projects, Resolution 2024-01
 A motion to approve the amendment was made by First Selectwoman Drugonis and seconded by Mayor Lauretti.

- i. 0002-0130: Drainage & outlet improvements, Ansonia (delete project)
- ii. <u>0015-0380:</u> Repair and Upgrade Fixed Loading Ramp, Water Street Dock, Bridgeport

- iii. <u>0083-0271:</u> Replace Highway Signs & Supports on Segments of CT-15 (Greenwich-Meriden) to reflect mileage-based numbering.
- iv. <u>0144-0199</u>: CT-127 Trail Connector, Trumbull, move project to different year.
- v. <u>0173-0519:</u> Replace traffic control signals, District 3
- vi. 0173-0531: Replace traffic control signals, District 3

Mr. Flatto thanked the board for its support of the Bridgeport project and has high hopes for a future high-speed ferry.
