WHEREAS, The University of Connecticut (UCONN) applied for and was awarded under the 2022 USDA-NIFA Urban, Indoor and Emerging Agriculture Grant Program under the application "Expanding Connecticut Urban Agriculture through Vacant Lot Activation and Peri Urban Farmland Access linking"; and

WHEREAS, UCONN requested MetroCOG be a collaborator on the grant application to assist with communication to municipal leaders, development of criteria for parcel suitability, provide local zoning guidance, work with student interns and take part in the Project Advisory Team; and

WHEREAS, UCONN has allocated MetroCOG \$5,000 per year for four years for this work;

WHEREAS, MetroCOG applied for and received EPA Brownfields Assessment Cooperative Agreement (BF-00A01418), in the amount of \$500,000 to characterize and environmentally investigate brownfields sites in the Greater Bridgeport Region; and

WHEREAS, MetroCOG solicits candidate sites for assessment activities eligible for funding through EPA's Brownfields Assessment Cooperative Agreement (BF-00A01418); and

WHEREAS, The Town of Fairfield has applied for funding for a limited Phase II Environmental Assessment at 488 Tunxis Hill Road, a site owned by the Town of Fairfield; and

WHEREAS, MetroCOG, utilizing funds from our *United States Environmental Protection Agency's Cooperative Agreement BF-00A01418*, will conduct a Phase II Assessment on behalf of The Town of Fairfield at 488 Tunxis Hill Road furthering the goals of MetroCOG's Regional Brownfields Program;
